- > PACU(590) & Cardio Thoracic (746) Patients
- > Patients in last year =1336

AIMS

- Reduce our Carbon Footprint
- Reduce Costs and single use plastics
- Enhance Patient Recovery reduce hospital stay



Making Cardiac ITU Green

- ► The NHS is responsible for 5% of the UK's carbon admissions.
- Intensive care units generate massive amount of single use plastic waste and energy usage which has a negative impact on the environment and contribute to global climate changes.
- Our aim is to reduce plastic usage and carbon footprint.
- Reducing routine "daily blood testing"



Reducing single use plastics

- Cost of large surgical waste bins. 1 bin=£9.26
- ► 1.5 bins per day on average= £13.89
- Per week= £97.23
- Per year= £5055.96
- Cost savings of £4946.76 a year (98%) and 240 kg CO2 a year



AMBU bags. Cost £5.34 each. 1336 patients admitted this year only 56 used. Saving of £6835.

Introducing black and recycling waste

Over 2 weeks orange waste reduced by 50% separated into recycling and black bin waste

Enhanced Recovery After Cardiac Surgery (ERACS)

- This is a policy that is currently being implemented by staff nurse Kaylee Marson and the ERACS team which Aims to reduce hospital stay for routine Cardiac Patients from 7 days to 5 days.
- Advantages are:
- Earlier discharges
- Less chance of HAI
- Better patient experience and recovery
- From our 2024, 746 Cardio- thoracic patients admitted It is projected that this will save an average of 2 days per patient, 1 ITU/HDU day and 1 ward day, therefore potential savings of 1492 days and average of 204,750kg of co2.
- Cost saving of for 1 day in ITU/HDU (AV £1881/ day) based on 746 patient= £1,403,226. 1 day Ward bed (£350) saving= £261,100.

Challenging the existing practices of "we have always done it this way"



- Life Cycle Analysis for our 5 "daily" routine pathology tests FBC, U&E, Coag, CRP, LFT's and magnesium.
- ► The tests range from 49 g - 116 g CO2. Our test savings for all 5 routine blood tests cost £19.28 and 885 grams of CO2 Per patient
- Also impacts unnecessary patient blood loss + risks of errors.

Routine daily blood testing



- ► Introduce set days for blood tests for routine post op patient instead of everyday. Full set of routine blood tests cost £19.28 and 885 grams of CO₂.
- Cardiac pt's to reduce blood tests by 1 day. This year we admitted 396 cardiac patient so projected savings for next year= £7634 and 350kg CO₂
- Thoracic patients reduce blood tests by 3 days. Average 350 patients a year saving = £23 244 and 929kg c02
- PACU patients reduce by 2 days. 590 PACU patients = £22 750 and 1044kg of c02

Pharmaceuticals







- > 12% of health related co2
- Reduction in IV paracetamol £0.72, oral £0.02. (97% saving)
- CO2 310g IV, 38g oral (88% saving)
- Nebs prn cost of the drug plus face mask and giving set
- Omeprazole now oral replace IV Post op-IV drug £1.24 opposed to £0.03 oral
- Saving on the IV drugs, giving sets £0.97, needle syringe and mixing fluid. Need cost and co2
