Reducing Single-Use Plastic and Waste in Labs

Problem Statement:

Globally, labs produced **5.5 millions tonnes** of **plastic waste in 2014**. Single-use plastic and waste generated in the labs is having a negative impact on climate change.

In 2016, as much as **24% of all deaths worldwide** were attributable to the **environment** – this is roughly **13.7 million deaths a year**.





Reducing Single-Use Plastic and Waste in Labs

Aim:

By November 2025, we will have saved 1,400kg tonnes of CO₂ annually.

This is the equivalent of 442,105 pipette tips.

At this rate of expansion this will equate to saving 1 life a year by Nov 2030!

4,432 tonnes of CO₂ is the equivalent carbon emissions of saving one life a year.

(Equivalent to 1 million 400 pipette tips)
