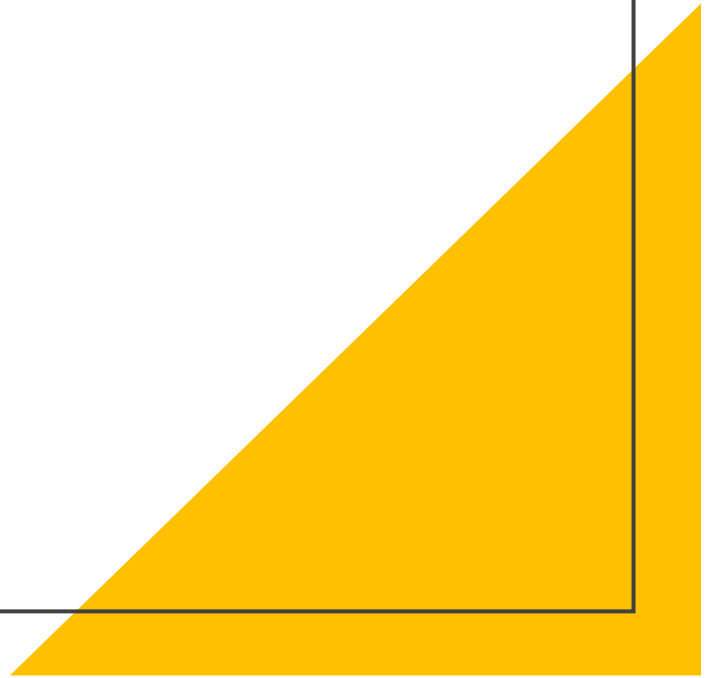


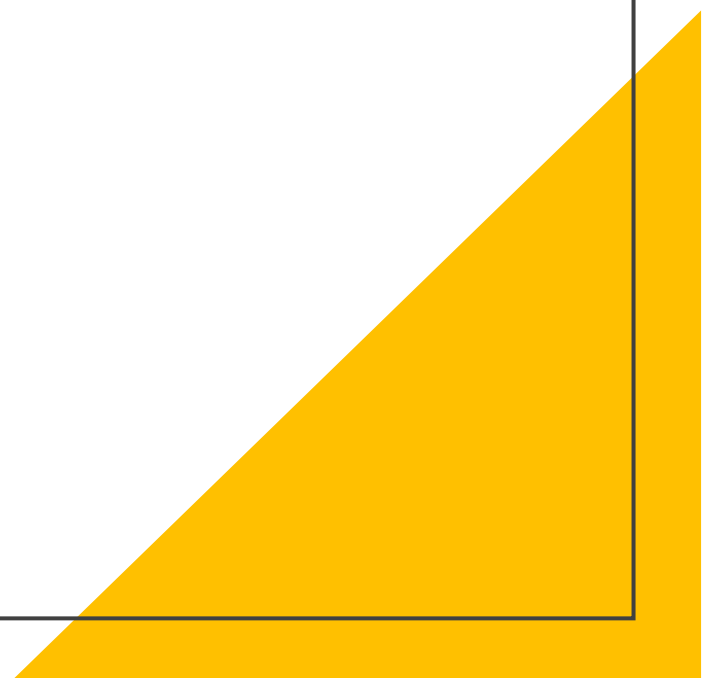


Problem Statement

- Respiratory illness is common and a major cause of school absence, unscheduled care appointments and hospital admissions.
 - Children still die of asthma. Poorly managed respiratory conditions will stop a child having a full and carefree childhood.
 - Repeated reports and audits have highlighted avoidable failings that contribute to poor quality of life, asthma attacks and death. Despite this, only 30% of children with asthma receive the basics of asthma care.

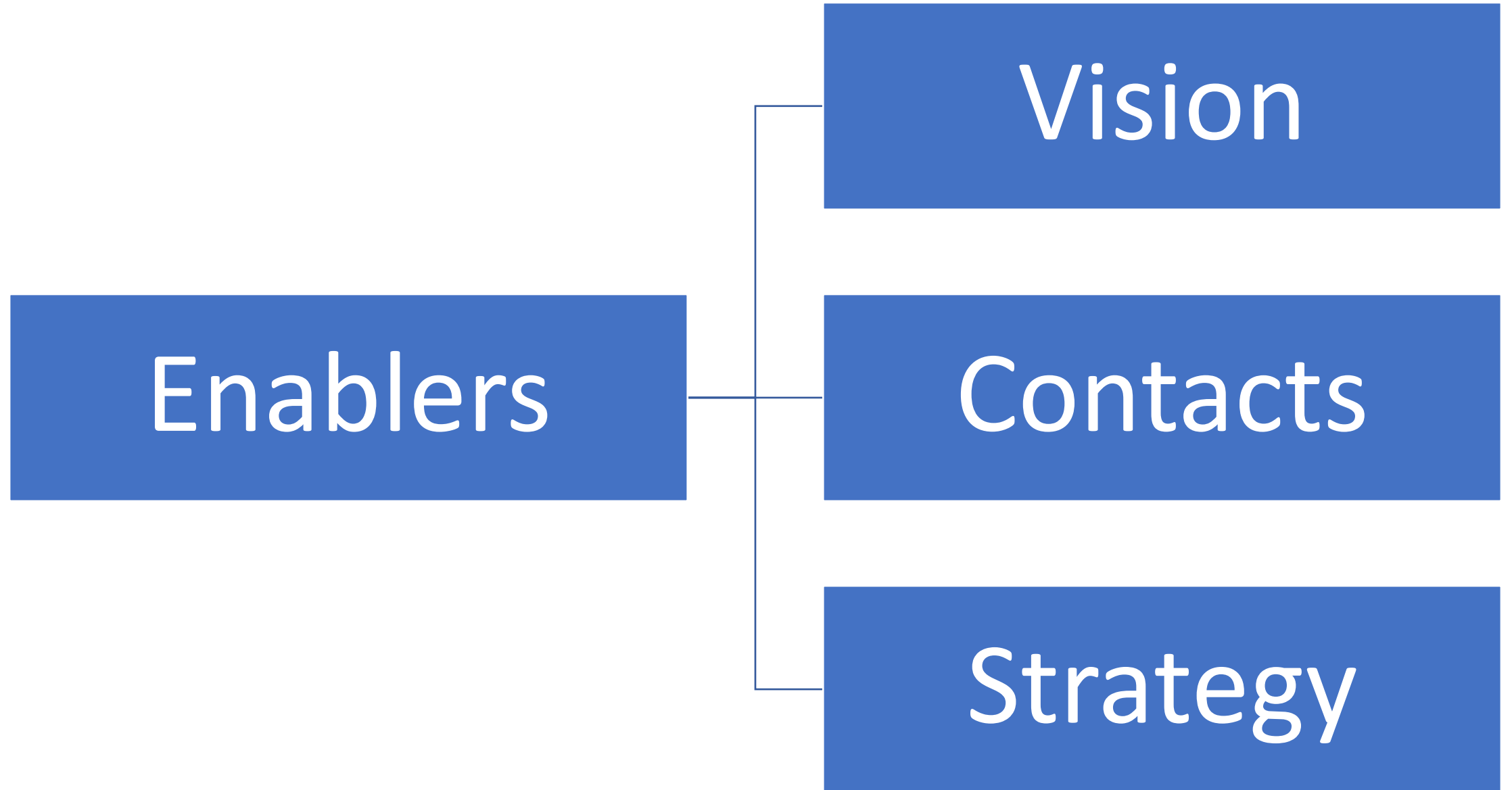

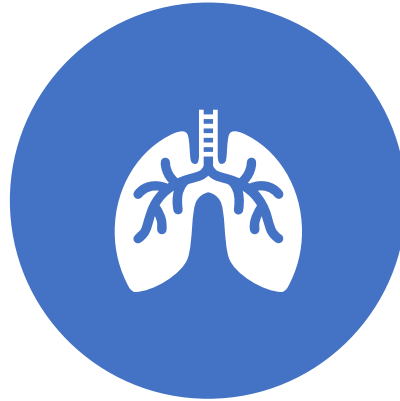
